Dear Overlake Family,

First, we love you! We never stop praying for you and are so honored to be on this journey of following Jesus together. Second, we can't wait to see you at one of the upcoming Vision Nights where we will be sharing what's ahead and celebrating where we are going. You can join us on Sunday 9/19 @ 6pm (in-person with kids programming for infant – 5<sup>th</sup> grade) or on Sunday 9/26 @ 6pm (online) – <u>RSVP here</u>.

Two-months ago we provided a mid-year financial update - <u>here</u> - and since then we've celebrated **baptisms**, seen more **new people** join the OCC family and **raised over \$25,000** for our ministry partner - *Not Abandoned* - towards the opening of an Employment Education Center in Pattaya, Thailand to empower exploited women through restoration, learning opportunities and job skills training.

## Great things are happening here, near & far!

Now as summer transitions to fall, we want to share another important financial update:

- Last month, the elders unanimously **approved the sale of a property** the church owns to invest the funds into relaunching ministries. (It will be listed later this month and we have a solution moving forward to address the hospitality role this townhome had been providing in the past.)
- Due to the Delta variant, the building and parking lot rental income we had anticipated returning this fall will be **delayed into 2022**. (Thankfully, one smaller contract for parking lot rental begins next month.)
- Current weekly average for gifts, tithes & offerings to the general ministry fund is continuing to hover at **\$55K/week**, below the \$70K/week affirmed budget for 2021.
- The remaining Payroll Protection Program (PPP) funds we qualified for will continue to bridge this \$15K/week deficit into November.

We are grateful for the provision of PPP funds and how rental income has historically covered ministry expenses. We are also aware **a sustainable solution is required** and free of another outside dependency.

There is one! It's more than sustainable. It's missional. It's biblical. It's the way of Jesus. It's an invitation for all of us. To give first, faithfully, fearlessly and freely of the resources the Lord has entrusted to each of us.

Currently, all the ministry happening in and through OCC is **with less than 50%** of us engaged in regular reoccurring giving. We are operating at only half our capacity – that's both alarming and encouraging. If that percentage were to increase to 65%, then we quickly bury the deficit, however, let's forget about aiming to cover a deficit, let's aim to be like the church in Acts – where **100% of us are all in!** Can you imagine...
